

Pre- Marital Requirements

Marriage License

A Marriage License must be issued in the Town Clerk's Office in the Town where the wedding will occur.

When visiting the Town Clerk's Office to obtain your marriage license, please bring suitable identification such as a driver's license or passport. In addition, the State of Connecticut requires that you provide your social security number.

- Both parties must appear in the same Clerk's office in person, must swear to the information provided on the application and both must sign the application. You may appear at separate times in the Clerk's office to complete the application, however the license will not be issued until both parties have presented themselves and provided all of the necessary information and signatures.
- Applicants under 18 years of age must have parental consent.
- Applicants under 16 years of age must have written consent of their parents and the presiding Judge of Probate.
- There is no waiting period; the license is issued immediately if all requirements are met.
- A BLOOD TEST IS NO LONGER REQUIRED IN THE STATE OF CONNECTICUT
- Marriage License is valid for 65 days after issuance; if not used within that time it will become null and void.
- Marriage License fee : \$ 30.00
- Town Clerk hours are currently 8:30 am to 4:30 pm Monday through Wednesday, 8:30 am to 6:00 pm Thursday and 8:30am to 3:00 pm Fridays. Appointments can be arranged for other times by calling 860-923-9900.
